# RESEARCH GRANTS

The Edith Saurer Fund awards research grants to outstanding domestic and foreign **postdoctoral scholars** whose current work specifically addresses issues of **social inequality from the perspectives of gender, class and culture**. Particular attention is paid to projects that deal with Europe from the early modern period to the 20th century and pursue comparative and transnational approaches.

**ESF grants are one-off, project-based and are only awarded to projects that are not yet completed.**

Exhibitions, events, travel costs (journeys, stays) and the like are **not funded**. By submitting a proposal, applicants commit themselves to completing their work within the deadline specified in the application. As a rule, this should **not exceed two years**, exceptions require a conclusive justification.
